Write a story about being a robot for a day. What jobs would you do? Where would you go?

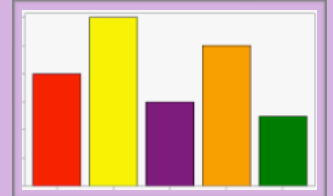


Will technology help us in the future or destroy us?

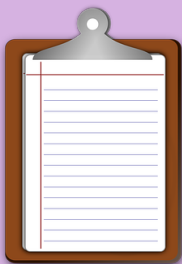
Maths

Teach someone at home how to use a specific type of technology. This could be TT Rock Stars, Purple Mash or a game you play on a tablet.

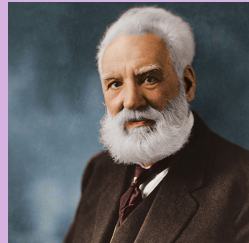

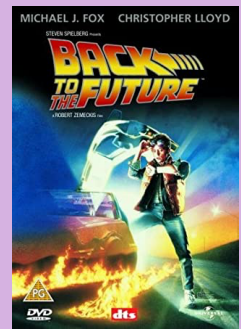
Go on a virtual visit to the Science Museum at www.sciencemuseum.org.uk

Investigate famous inventors of technology and the impact they have had.

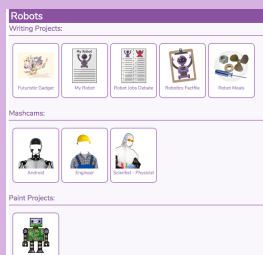


Watch the film Back to the Future with your parents. (This is a PG film.)
